THE VINTAGE:

A dry start to the winter followed by timely spring rains. The summer was cool and mild which allowed fruit to ripen very slowly resulting in strong acidities and deep colours for reds with full flavours and lower sugar levels. A very strong vintage for the region.

Vintage Rating—9/10

THE WINEMAKING:

The fruit was hand-harvested and grapes were gently de-stemmed. The free-run juice was fermented using natural yeasts, followed by a long, cool fermentation between 10-12°c .

THE WINE:

Chalky mineral aromatics with lemon and lime. Tight knit acidity with chalky mineral flavours coming though on the pallet. Acidity is long and fine with a steely structure and lengthy finish.
