2020 Great Southern Riesling

THE VINTAGE:

A very dry winter and spring (driest in 100 years). These dry conditions continued throughout summer. Good rainfalls in February provided much needed moisture. Very low crops but exceptional whites and reds.

THE WINEMAKING:

The fruit was hand-harvested and grapes were gently de-stemmed. The free-run juice was fermented using natural yeasts, followed by a long, cool fermentation between 10-12 $^{\circ}$ c.

THE WINE:

Chalky mineral aromatics with lemon and lime. Tight knit acidity with chalky mineral flavours coming through on the palate. Acidity is long and fine with a steely structure and lengthy finish.
